

SENIOR PASTOR ANNOUNCEMENT

Upon retirement of our current Senior Pastor, Robert V. Shipman, Sr. at the Prince of Peace Baptist Church of Philadelphia, the Pastoral Search Committee is prayerfully seeking a Senior Pastor, called by God, to minister, counsel, lead and further the spiritual growth of this congregation.

We are searching for a Senior Pastor with the following gifts, skills, and qualifications:

- **Training & Experience:** Must have a minimum of 10 years in a ministerial or pastoral role within the Baptist church denomination.
- Education: Must possess a bachelor's degree. A master's degree in theology or religious studies a plus.
- Affiliations: Affiliation with the National Baptist Convention, Lott Carey, or other African American Baptist organizations.
- **Certification & Licenses:** Ordination and License within the Baptist denomination is a requirement. Certification in family and marital counseling is a plus.
- **Communication:** Excellent verbal, non-verbal and written skills to convey messages to inspire the congregation, church staff, other clergy members, and the Strawberry Mansion community on a consistent basis. Exceptional interpersonal communication skills are a must.
- **Leadership:** Must provide sound leadership to guide the congregation towards common goals. Note: sound leadership a willingness to train/teach, influence, inspire, know yourself, and your people.
- **Organization:** Must possess strong organizational and time-management skills to maintain a healthy work-life balance while meeting the needs of the church.
- **Teaching:** Must provide a thorough understanding of the Bible and be capable of teaching the congregation how to apply its instruction and grow in their faith.
- Empathy/Compassion: Must be understanding and able to relate to the feelings, emotions, plights, and hardships of others (people/congregation) and a sincere willingness to help, spiritually guide and counsel those in need.

Note: (Assisting only within boundaries of the church's abilities and only within the pastor's area of expertise. Recommend outside resources for additional help if needed.)

• **Creativity/Innovation:** Must be creative, forward thinking, open to new ideas, and able to embrace technology to create new ways of doing things or to enhance traditional ways of doing things for the betterment of the Prince of Peace Baptist Church.

Note: (The above skill sets should not compromise the integrity of the church's core beliefs, ministry, praise and worship, system outreach, and church doctrine.)
